One joint police and fire and rescue station;</p> <p style="margin-left: 20px;">c. Three fire and rescue stations.</p> <p>(2) Expiration of Tax Rate Change. The increased sales and use tax rate will be implemented and related revenues collected beginning as soon as practicable after voter approval and continuing for a period of not more than three years.</p> <p>(3) Lincoln-Lancaster County Cooperative Agreement. Revenues from the tax rate change shall be used, in part, to fund the City's share of a cooperative interlocal agreement between the City of Lincoln and Lancaster County, Nebraska for the cooperative use of the 911 public safety radio communications system, for the joint and mutual benefit and protection of said City and County, and to review the use of such system to ensure it provides adequate public safety communications capabilities to the City and the County.</p> <p>(4) Citizens' Oversight and Accountability Committee.
