Lancaster County Treasurer Announces Electronic Notification System

Lincoln, NE – November 17, 2017 – The Lancaster County Treasurer, Andy Stebbing has announced that his office will begin utilizing an email reminder system to help notify Lancaster County property owners of important tax dates. The system is voluntary and property owners must sign up to receive electronic notifications.

Property owners can sign up to receive emails by simply providing their email address at Lancaster.ne.gov/treasurer. “We understand that life can be hectic at times and we are hoping that this service will help citizens with timely payments of their property taxes” Stebbing said. “There is a statutory interest rate assessed of fourteen percent per annum for delinquent taxes which can add up quickly if not paid on time”, Stebbing said. Tax bills and notices will also continue to be sent via regular mail to all property owners.

Stebbing also noted that 2017 tax statements will be mailed the first week of December and the taxes may be paid starting on December 1st. “If you do not receive your statement, please call our office for a copy or visit our website to view or print your tax statement”, Stebbing said.
