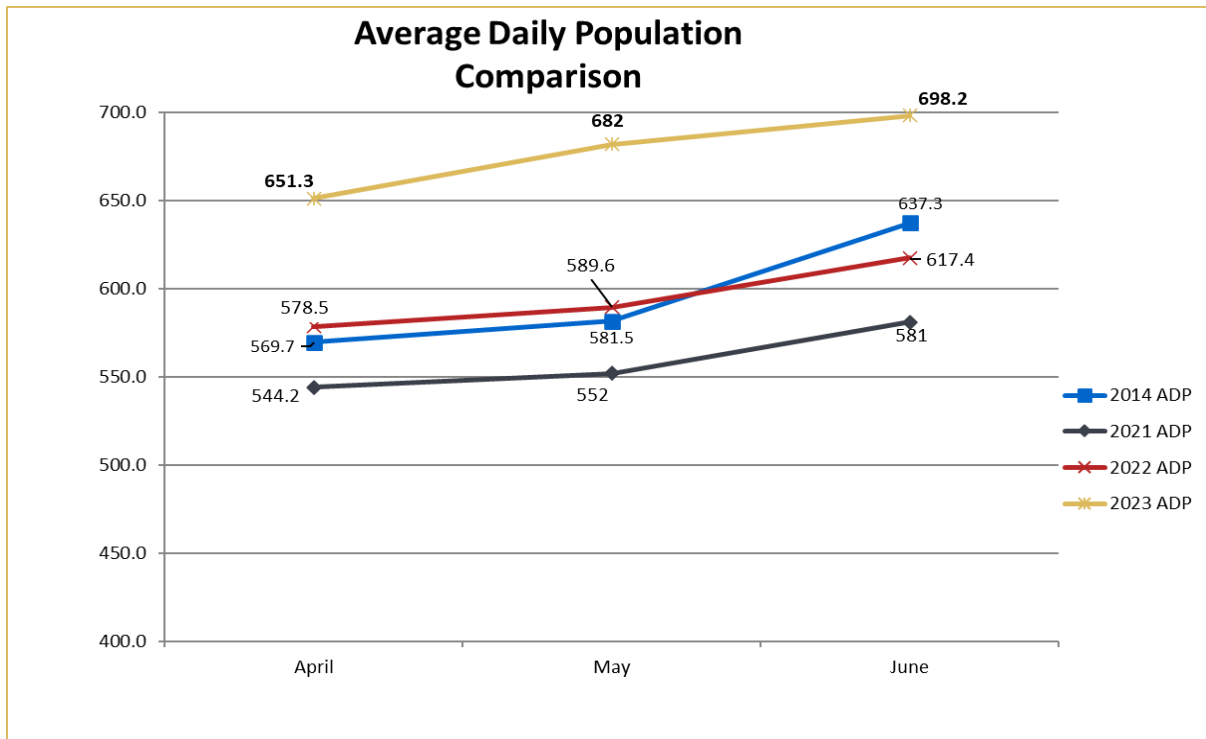

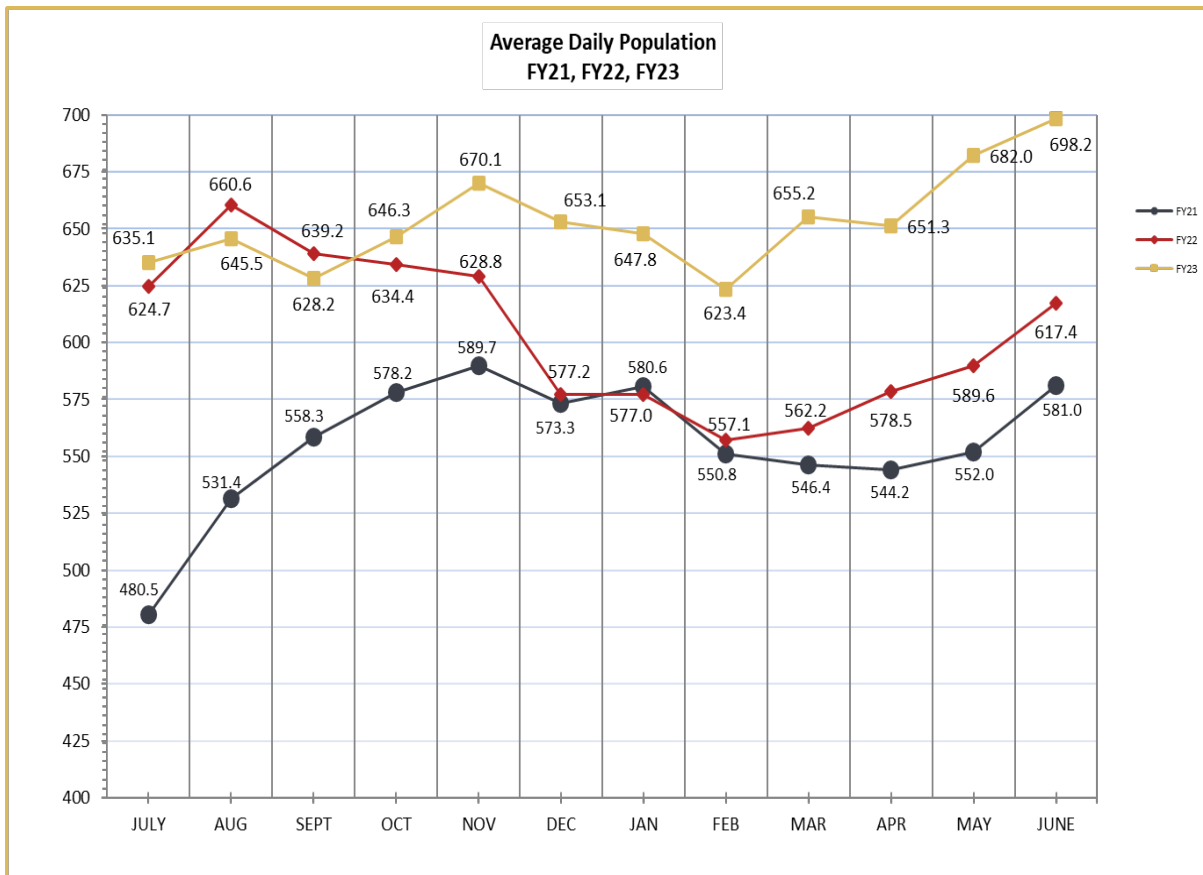
Average Daily Population

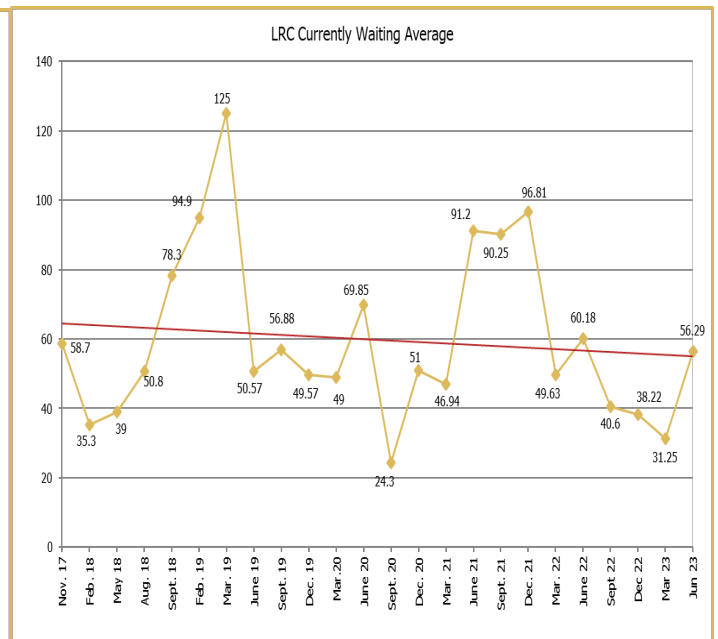
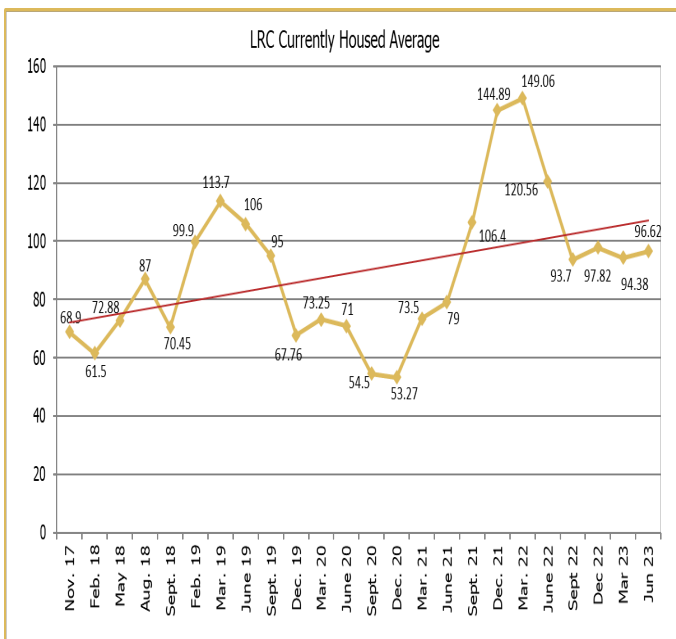

Veterans Court

- Current Participants: 5
 - We have two individuals bonding in this month on July 19th and another on July 26th.
 - Next Graduation scheduled: N/A
 - Last Gradation was April 20th, 2023.
- Recidivism:
 - Program was established on April 17th, 2017. The program is approximately 18- 24 months.
 - 24 individuals have graduated from the program.
 - Only three individuals have been removed from the program unsuccessful since the start in 2017.
 - Five graduates have received new law charges with only one being convicted at this time.

DUI Court:

- Current Participants: 40
 - Since the last Justice Council on May 5th, we have added seven participants to the program.
 - Five participants have been unsuccessfully removed since the start of the program.
- Recidivism: We do not have enough data at this time.
 - The Court was established on June 22, 2021. The program is approximately 18- 24 months.
 - First Graduation was this year January 17, 2023
 - Three Graduated
 - Second Graduation this year was on April 18th, 2023.
 - Five Graduated
 - Upcoming third Graduation class this year will be on August 29th, 2023.
 - Six projected to graduate.
