Agency Recommendations:

The LLCHD's Air Quality Program recommends this appointment. Given Ms. VanWormer's education and experience, she would be a highly valued asset to the Air Pollution Control Advisory Board. She holds a Bachelor of Science in Zoology, a Doctorate of Philosophy majoring in Epidemiology, and is a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine. She is currently an Assistant Professor of Practice and the One Health Coordinator UNL's School of Veterinary Medicine and Biomedical Sciences. As the One Health coordinator, she works with students, multi-disciplinary researchers, and non-academic stakeholders, linking diverse tools and perspectives to address complex health challenges. Ms. VanWormer's research into the relationships between humans, animals, and the environment would benefit this Board, as air pollution, the climate, and public health are all strongly related to one another.
