 - Allows seamless information sharing of voice, text, pictures and videos
- Geospatial Call Routing
 - Based on Geographic Information System (GIS) Data
 - State working with Counties to get the most up to date and accurate information
 - Streets, Address Locations, Emergency Services Boundaries

- One Entity to assign and update addresses for all of Lancaster County

-Proposed in 2021

- Interlocal Agreement presented and signed by several Villages

- Organizational Changes

- Updates to Interlocal Agreement needed

Benefits

- Consistency of addressing County-wide
 - Quicker updates to 911 GIS Data
 - More accurate emergency call routing
- System Expertise
- Redundancy
 - Multiple people will be trained to prevent backlog
- Single Point of Contact
