- (A) ~~Notwithstanding any other provisions of the LLCAPCRS, the following Acid Rain federal regulations, published at 40 CFR Parts 72, 75, and 76, as in effect on July 1, 2020, are hereby adopted and incorporated herein for purposes of implementing an Acid Rain program that meets the requirements of Title IV of the Act:~~
- (1) ~~The provisions of 40 CFR Part 72: Permits Regulation, as in effect on July 1, 2014, for-~~
- (A)(a) ~~For purposes of implementing an Acid Rain program that meets the requirements of Title IV of the Act, are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference. The, the term "permitting authority" shall mean the Department and the term "Administrator" shall mean the Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.~~
 - (B)(b) ~~If the provisions or requirements of 40 CFR Part 72 conflict with other provisions of the LLCAPCRS as they apply to affected sources, the Part 72 provisions and requirements shall apply and take precedence.~~
 - (C)(2) ~~The provisions of 40 CFR Part 75: Continuous Emission Monitoring, as in effect on July 1, 2014, for purposes of implementing an Acid Rain program that meets the requirements of Title IV of the Act, are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference.~~
 - (D)(3) ~~The provisions of 40 CFR Part 76: Acid Rain Nitrogen Oxides Emission Reduction Program, as in effect on July 1, 2014, for purposes of implementing an Acid Rain program that meets the requirements of Title IV of the Act, are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference.~~
