The meeting began at 1:35 p.m. A copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available.


Hansen led the group on a tour of the CenterPointe Campus for Health and Wellbeing currently under construction at 2200 South 10th Street (Trabert Hall building). He emphasized that services provided at the facility will benefit many in the community, including those in the immediate neighborhood who may be underserved in the area of medical care.

Points of interest along the tour included the serenity garden, health clinic space, including exam and consultation rooms and a pharmacy, staff areas, client apartments and community meeting space. Space on the third and fourth floors will be completed by December 2022. The second floor and clinic will open in February 2023.

Hansen said the final project cost will be around \$27,000,000 and noted it would not have been possible without the County's support and the generosity of the community.

The meeting ended at 2:37 p.m.
