- A.** Lancaster County Correctional Facility Joint Public Agency proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2022-23


Dennis Meyer, Budget and Fiscal Director, was administered the oath. He stated the total expenditures will be \$4,055,300 for principal and interest on the bonds. Property valuations increased 4.01% in the County and 4.23% in the City of Lincoln. There are seven more principal payments on the bonds. When the Lancaster County Correctional Facility Joint Public Agency was formed the combined levy was over \$.03. This year, the levy will be \$.013285.

No one appeared in support, opposition, or in a neutral position.

The public hearing was closed.
