- Discussion on the data of the 65 youth with no order
 - 38 Male
 - 27 Female
 - 32 White
 - 15 Hispanic
 - 11 Black
 - 4 Asian/Pacific Islander
 - 3 American Indian/Alaskan
 - 26 Truancy Petitions
 - Other charges were Assault, Theft Shoplifting, Theft Unlawful Taking, Criminal Mischief, Disturbing the Peace, Resist Arrest, Possession of Marijuana
- Discussion on how to limit the number of continuances
 - Texting reminders to youth on upcoming court appearances.
 - Have one-on-one discussions with the three judges on their thoughts on the reason for the continuances and how to get to disposition sooner.
 - How to make sure evaluations are completed in a timely manner? Family needs to follow through with their part in this process.

- How to make sure families are meeting with PDI Officer?
- Discussed possible pilot program with the judges
 - Would select a certain group i.e. the younger youth, felony offenses, gun offenses.
 - Work out a time frame on expediting the process from the date of the offense to disposition.
 - Map out a time frame for each agency involved.
 - Mindy Vogel and Becky Steiner will work together on implementing the time frame.
