WHEREAS, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 35-530 to 35-536 (Reissue 2008), provides that the territory within the incorporated area of any village or city may be included within a rural or suburban fire protection district; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2009, the Lancaster County Clerk certified that the joint resolution of the Village of Hallam, Nebraska, and the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District Planning, initiating the proceedings to include the territory within the Village of Hallam into the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District, complied with the requirements of Neb. Rev. Stat. §35-531; and

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2009, the Gage County Clerk certified that the joint resolution of the Village of Hallam, Nebraska, and the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District Planning, initiating the proceedings to include the territory within the Village of Hallam into the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District, complied with the requirements of Neb. Rev. Stat. §35-531; and

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2009, the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, and the Board of Supervisors of Gage County, Nebraska, conducted a joint meeting and public hearing regarding whether the territory within the incorporated area of the Village of Hallam, Nebraska, should be included within the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District; and

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2009, the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, determined that the inclusion of the Village of Hallam, Nebraska, within the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District is suited to the general fire protection policy of Lancaster County, Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2009, the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, determined the boundaries of the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District. A map or plate diagramming and describing said boundaries of the Hallam Rural Fire Protection

District is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "B", and is incorporated herein by this reference;

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2009, the Board of Supervisors of Gage County, Nebraska, determined the boundaries of the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District. A map or plate diagramming and describing said boundaries of the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "B", and is incorporated herein by this reference; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, pursuant to the authority under Neb. Rev. Stat. §37-533, that:

- A. The inclusion of the Village of Hallam, Nebraska, within the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District is suited to the general fire protection policy of Lancaster County, Nebraska; and
- B. The boundaries of the territory to be included within the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District is the territory within the incorporated area of the Village of Hallam, Lancaster County, Nebraska, a map or plate of said territory to be included in the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "A", and is incorporated herein by this reference; and
- C. The boundaries of the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District are described and diagrammed in Exhibit "B", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, by the Board of Supervisors of Gage County, Nebraska, pursuant to the authority under Neb. Rev. Stat. §37-533, that:

- A. The inclusion of the Village of Hallam, Nebraska, within the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District is suited to the general fire protection policy of Gage County, Nebraska; and
- B. The boundaries of the territory to be included within the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District is the territory within the incorporated area of the Village of Hallam, Lancaster County, Nebraska, a map or plate of said territory to be included in the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "A", and is incorporated herein by this reference; and
- C. The boundaries of the Hallam Rural Fire Protection District are described and diagramed in Exhibit "B", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
