Whereas: The Hazard Elimination Program is a "core safety program" for Highway Safety Construction. This program is provided for in *Title 23, Section 148 of U.S. Code*, and is part of the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) which is provided for in *23 CFR, Part 924*, which is administered by the Federal Highway Administration,

Whereas: The State of Nebraska maintains a Multi-Disciplinary High Risk Rural Road Committee to oversee facets of the HSIP; and

Whereas: The High Risk Rural Road Committee has determined that it is desirable to install durable pavement markings and rumble stripes on county roads to prevent or minimize lane departure crashes in the State of Nebraska; and

Whereas: The High Risk Rural Road Committee, on February 2, 2009, approved a project known as HRRR-STWD(092)- Pavement Marking and Rumble Stripes to accomplish the following:

Install durable pavement markings and/or rumble stripes on centerlines, edgelines, no passing zones and traffic control locations on paved roads within the County.

Be It Resolved: That the State of Nebraska is hereby requested to act on behalf of Lancaster County to program a project for the installation of the pavement marking products shown on Exhibit "A" (Highway Map) and Exhibit "B" (Spreadsheet Response) attached,

Be It Further Resolved: That sufficient funds of Lancaster County are now available or will be made available and are hereby pledged to the Nebraska Department of Roads in the amount and at the required time for the purpose of matching Federal funds for the contemplated construction.

The cost to Lancaster County is estimated to be \$28,400.00 which is 10% of the work described herein.

Be It Further Resolved: That the Chairman of the County Board is authorized to sign this Resolution on behalf of said Board. In addition, the Chairman and the Highway Superintendent are hereby authorized to sign the Certificate of Compliance upon completion of the work.


