AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS IN LANCASTER COUNTY ) RESOLUTION NO. R-09-0081

WHEREAS, NEB.REV.STAT. § 60-6,121 (Reissue 2004) provides that placement of traffic control devices is within the jurisdiction of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineering Department has informed the County Board that it is in the best interest of the traveling public to install the following signs at the following locations:

- 1. Install a "School Bus Stop Ahead" sign (S3-1) on Firth Rd. approximately 500 feet west of 17185 Firth Rd. for eastbound traffic.
2. Install an "Engine braking prohibited" sign (R42-1) on South 148th Street 1000 feet south of Highway 34 for northbound traffic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, that authorization is hereby given to install and remove such traffic signs at the locations designated herein.
