RESOLUTION NO. R-10-0034

WHEREAS, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 77-1502(1) provides that the county board of equalization shall meet for the purpose of reviewing and deciding written protests filed pursuant to Section 77-1502 beginning on or after June 1 and ending on or before July 25 of each year; and

WHEREAS, Section 77-1502(1) further provides that the county board in a county with a population of more than one hundred thousand inhabitants may adopt a resolution to extend the deadline for hearing protests regarding real property from July 25 to August 10 of each year; and

WHEREAS, such resolution must be adopted before July 25 of each year and will affect the time for hearing protests for that year only; and


WHEREAS, the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners desires to extend the deadline for hearing protests in Lancaster County from July 25, 2010, to August 10, 2010, for those protests filed in 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Board of County Commissioners that the deadline for hearing protests regarding real property in Lancaster County shall be extended from July 25, 2010, to August 10, 2010, for those protests filed in 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 77-1502(5), the County Clerk's Office shall mail to any protester written notice of the County Board of Equalization's decision on or before August 18, 2010.


