RESOLUTION NO. R-10-0057

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Legislature enacted LB 861 during the 2010 Legislative session to allow local governing bodies to extend closing time for the sale of alcohol at bars until 2 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, extending the closing time for bars could result in an increase in the number of public offenses, including driving under the influence, public intoxication, assault, and other alcohol-related crimes and problems; and

WHEREAS, the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners believes the public safety will be better served with a 1 a.m. bar closing time for all local jurisdictions within Lancaster County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners reaffirms its strong support for a 1 a.m. bar closing time, and all other local governing bodies located within Lancaster County are encouraged to join the County Board in maintaining a 1 a.m. bar closing time.


