WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 39-1402 (Reissue 2007), general supervision and control of the public roads of each county is vested in the county board; and

WHEREAS, the Lancaster County Engineer is the person responsible for the maintenance of county roads in Lancaster County, Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer recommends requiring operators of oversized vehicles or loads to apply for a Special Trip Permit and be subject to certain conditions when using county roads. A copy of the Special Trip Permit and its conditions is attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by this reference; and


WHEREAS, the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners finds that adoption of such a permit process and related conditions is in the best interest and safety of the traveling public.






PERMISSION IS HEREBY GRANTED TO _____ FOR THE OPERATION OF THE VEHICLE OR THE VEHICLE AND LOAD DESCRIBED HEREIN OVER THE ROUTE SHOWN ON THE ATTACHED MAP. SAID PERMISSION IS SUBJECT TO STRICT COMPLIANCE WITH THE GENERAL PROVISIONS AND THE SPECIAL PROVISIONS THAT FOLLOW.

PERMISSION FOR THE AGRICULTURAL OVERLOAD PERMIT IS SUBJECT TO STRICT COMPLIANCE WITH STATE STATUTES PERTAINING TO THESE TYPE OF PERMITS AND THE FOLLOWING GENERAL PROVISIONS AND THE SPECIAL PROVISIONS THAT FOLLOW.

***** General Provisions *****

1. The Special Permit shall be in the possession of the operator of the vehicle during the movement on the highway, and he will show permit on demand to any law enforcement officer or any authorized employee of Lancaster County.
2. The Special Permit for any movement does not waive any license requirement on the vehicle.
3. The permit is in effect only upon the condition that the vehicle, combination of vehicles, or other objects must of necessity be moved over the highway to reach their intended destination.
4. The wheels of all vehicles, including trailers, described in this permit shall be equipped with pneumatic tires.
5. The movement of vehicles or the combination of vehicles and loads covered by this permit shall be made during the daylight hours and only on weekdays. **No Saturday, Sunday, or Holiday moves will be permitted unless specifically indicated in the special provisions.**
6. **The permit shall not be construed as waiving any load limitation which has been, or which may be, established by the posting of load limit signs on any road or structure thereon.**
7. The operator must comply with all laws of the State of Nebraska and all the rules and regulations of Lancaster County, Nebraska, which have been or which may be hereinafter adopted relative to the use of the roads for the movement of special vehicles or objects.
8. The operator must maintain in good working condition all lights and brakes on the vehicle as provided by State Statute.
9. The operator must maintain and operate all vehicles or objects covered by this permit in accordance with all the requirements of the Motor Vehicle Law and all other laws applicable thereto. Operator is not relieved from complying with all ordinances, rules, and regulations governing the operation of a motor vehicle or combination of vehicles within the State of Nebraska, Lancaster County or any incorporated city, town, or village.
10. If the route designated for the move involves going under, through, or across any underpass, utility lines, signs, etc., and the appurtenances thereto, the operator of the vehicle will stop prior to entering the aforementioned improvements and ascertain whether or not sufficient horizontal and/or vertical clearance exists to permit the vehicle to proceed without damage to the aforesaid improvements.
11. The permit is granted with the understanding that the permittee assumes all liability and responsibility for all property damages or personal injuries sustained by any person which may occur as a consequence of the movement. Lancaster County will not be deemed liable for or responsible in any manner for damage to public or private property or for personal injuries which may occur as a consequence of the movement. No implied warranties regarding horizontal or vertical clearances or the load carrying capacity of culverts, and other structures, or the lack thereof, are to be inferred by the permittee as a result of the issuance of this permit.
12. The Special Permit will be issued only on the highways of Lancaster County for which the County has the maintenance responsibility. Special Permits will not be issued on any highway **not** under County maintenance.
13. **Prior to any movement of vehicles pursuant to this Special Trip Permit, the operator shall have on file with Lancaster County or produce at the time of issuance a certificate of insurance evidencing the following insurance coverage at the following minimal limits:**

Commercial General Liability Policy:

Bodily Injury	\$1,000,000 each occurrence; \$2,000,000 aggregate
Property Damage	\$1,000,000 each occurrence; \$2,000,000 aggregate

Automobile Liability Policy:

Bodily Injury and Property Damage \$1,000,000 Combined Single Limit

Workers Compensation Policy: Statutory Requirements

The aforementioned insurance policies shall be obtained from an insurance company which is authorized to do business in the State of Nebraska and shall name Lancaster County as an additional insured.

- 14. Dummy axles (air tag axles) must carry a minimum of 8% of the gross vehicle weight. In no case will a single axle alone or in a group carry more than 20,000 lbs.
- 15. An escort vehicle, both in front and to the rear of the vehicle carrying the load is required for a vehicle or vehicle and load exceeding fourteen feet six inches (14'-6") in width. The County Engineer reserves the right to require an escort at anytime he deems it necessary for the safety of the public.
- 16. The County Engineer, in order to assure the safety of the public, may require because of road conditions, size or weight of loads or vehicles, speed of the vehicle, or the volume of traffic that the applicant provide flagmen to safely stop oncoming traffic until the load has passed.
- 17. The operator shall re-erect traffic signs affected by the move the same day of the move. "Stop" signs shall be re-erected by permittee immediately after passage of the load. The operator shall remove all vegetation from the County's right-of-way which has been cut to accommodate passage of the load with three (3) calendar days of the move.
- 18. Failure by the operator to complete any signing work or clean-up work as specified in Paragraph 17 will result in Lancaster County performing the work at the operator's expense. The following cost schedule shall apply:

Repair or replace traffic sign	-	\$ 50.00
Repair or replace mounting post	-	\$ 50.00
Remove and dispose of trees or brush	-	\$100.00/hour

No future Special Trip Permits shall be issued to the operator company until ALL claims have been settled to the satisfaction of the County Engineer.

- 19. Failure by the hauler to comply with the General Conditions or the Special Provisions will render this permit null and void.
