WHEREAS, Gregory and Heidi Rettele request authority to located and occupy a temporary mobile home while building a permanent residence on property generally located at S.W. 14th Street and West Olive Creek Road, Lancaster County, Nebraska, legally described as follows:

A one acre portion of Lot 15, Irregular Tract (described as a rectangle being 160' north south and 272' east west, 360' west of the east property line and 60'north of the south property line) located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 16, Township 7 North, Range 6 East of the 6th P.M., Lancaster County, Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln-Lancaster County Planning Department recommends conditional approval of said Special Permit concluding that the proposal is in conformance with the County Zoning Resolution and the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2010, the Lincoln-Lancaster County Planning Commission conducted a public hearing on County Special Permit No. 07024B and voted 5-0 to recommend conditional approval; and

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, conducted a public hearing regarding County Special Permit No. 07024B and voted to approve said Special Permit with conditions; and

WHEREAS, all requirements of the Lancaster County Zoning Regulations have been met.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, that County Special Permit No. 07024B, for the authority to locate and occupy a mobile home while building a permanent residence on property generally located at S.W. 14th Street and West Olive Creek Road, Lancaster County, Nebraska, is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS:

1. This approval permits one temporary mobile home which shall be removed at the end of 24 months from the adoption of this permit or at the time of occupancy of the house, whichever comes first.
2. Construction of a new house shall be initiated within twelve months and completed within twenty four months of the County Board's approval of this special permit.
3. Once initiated, if the construction ceases for a period in excess of six months this permit shall terminate.
4. This permit is not renewable.
5. The construction plans shall comply with the approved plans.

STANDARD CONDITIONS:

6. The following conditions are applicable to all requests:
 - 6.1 The resolution's terms, conditions, and requirements bind and obligate the permittee, its successors and assigns.
 - 6.2 The applicant shall sign and return the letter of acceptance to the County Clerk within 60 days following the approval of the special permit, provided however, said 60-day period may be extended up to six months by administrative amendment. The applicant shall file a certified copy of the resolution approving the special permit and the letter of acceptance, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Attachment "A", with the Register of Deeds. The

applicant shall pay the applicable certification and recording fees in advance.



LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE


