WHEREAS, the purpose of the County Purchasing Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 23-3101 through 23-3115, (Reissue 2007), is to provide a uniform purchasing procedure for County purchases of equipment, supplies, other items of personal property, and services; and

WHEREAS, the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners has previously established a policy requiring that all purchases resulting in a contract receive a majority vote of approval from the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners prior to the contract being drawn by the Purchasing Department; and


WHEREAS, the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners desires to amend the purchasing policy to require that only purchases resulting in contracts for amounts equal to or greater than \$20,000.00 must receive a majority vote of approval from the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners prior to the contract being drawn by the Purchasing Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, effective immediately, the Lancaster County Purchasing Manual is amended to require that only purchases resulting in contracts for amounts equal to or greater than \$20,000 must receive a majority vote of approval from the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners prior to the contract being drawn by the Purchasing Department
