Graduated Incentives

The incentives listed below are typically what you should expect for various positive behaviors while a participant in the Adult Drug Court. Incentives are individualized to individual participants to ensure the incentives are targeted and rewarding. The goal of the team is to provide an incentive that will encourage positive behavior. You should expect an immediate incentive for any behavior that shows progression through the Drug Court program. During your time in Drug Court, it may be challenging to follow rules at first. But over time, with continued progress through the program, following the rules will become easier and you will be rewarded with less programming and less court appearances as you demonstrate trust and the tools you have learned during your time in the program. This chart does NOT cover every positive behavior, just the most common in Drug Court.

	<u>Proximal</u> <u>Behaviors that participants are already capable of engaging in (e.g. telling the truth and being on time) and are necessary for long term objectives to be completed.</u>	<u>Distal</u> <u>Behaviors that may take some time to achieve with the help of Drug Court (e.g. becoming employed and parenting skills may be distal goals). Distal goals will eventually become proximal goals.</u>
