Stat. §23-174.10 (Reissue 2007), the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners adopted procedures for the regulation of on-site water supply systems and on-site wastewater treatment systems prior to the sale, transfer, or conveyance of property in Lancaster County on February 28, 2006, under County Resolution No. 06-0005; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department has recommended an amendment to increase the fees for evaluation and review of Property Transfer Inspector reports and necessary site visits by the Health Director, as provided in Attachment "A," attached hereto and incorporated by this reference; and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2012, the Board of Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, conducted a public hearing regarding the adoption of the amendments to Resolution No. 06-0005, Procedures for the Inspection of On-Site Water Supply Systems and On-Site Wastewater Treatment Systems Prior to the Sale, Transfer, or Conveyance of Property in Lancaster County, Nebraska, as provided in Attachment "A"; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, the amendments to Resolution No. 06-0005, Procedures for the Inspection of On-Site Water Supply Systems and On-Site Wastewater Treatment Systems Prior to the Sale,




- (b) Property Transfer Inspector permit fees:
  - On-site Wastewater Treatment System  
(OWWTS) Property Transfer Inspector ..... \$30.00
  
  - On-site Waste Supply System (OWSS)  
Property Transfer Inspector ..... \$30.00
  
  - Both OWWTS & OWSS ..... \$50.00

All fees are payable to the Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department and shall be credited to the Health Fund. No fees will be refunded.
