AUTHORIZING INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS IN LANCASTER COUNTY )

RESOLUTION NO. R-12-0085 )

WHEREAS, NEB. REV. STAT. § 60-6,121 (Reissue 2004) provides that placement of traffic control devices is within the jurisdiction of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineering Department has informed the County Board that it is in the best interest of the traveling public to install "Emergency Vehicle" warning signs (W11-8) with 500 foot warning plaques (W16-2aP) for the Raymond Volunteer Fire Station located at 3201 Arbor Road. The location of the traffic signs will be at the following more particularly described locations:

- 1. One set 500 feet east of the drive for westbound traffic; and
2. One set 500 feet west of the drive for eastbound traffic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, that authorization is hereby given to install a traffic sign at the location designated herein.
