WHEREAS, a One and Six Year Road and Bridge Improvement Program for Lancaster County, Nebraska, for the fiscal year beginning 2013, has been prepared according to law by Don R. Thomas, the Lancaster County Engineer; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln-Lancaster County Planning staff found the Program to be generally in conformance with the 2040 Lincoln-Lancaster County Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, said Program has been presented at a public hearing before the Lincoln-Lancaster County Planning Commission on October 17, 2012; and

WHEREAS, after the public hearing, the Planning Commission agreed with the staff recommendation and recommended approval of the Program by a vote of 5-0, finding it was in general conformance with the 2040 Lincoln-Lancaster County Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2012, the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners conducted a public hearing regarding said Program; and

WHEREAS, based on public comment, the County Engineer has provided corrections to the County Board to be included in the Program, as outlined in a November 29, 2012 letter to the County Board, which is attached hereto and incorporated by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the One and Six Year Road and Bridge Construction Program as prepared

and recommended by the Lancaster County Engineer is on file with the County Clerk's Office, is incorporated herein by this reference.

WHEREAS, the County Board has found that the One and Six Year Road and Bridge Construction Program, including the corrections proposed in the attached November 29, 2012 letter, as prepared by the County Engineer, should be adopted.







SUBJECT: Adoption of the One and Six-Year Program

The annual road & bridge hearing was held on November 20, 2012 and testimony was received on a variety of topics. The following is a summary of the testimony received and my recommendations for any changes from the Program as submitted:

- 1) Al Benes of 20700 NW 98th Street has concerns about the sight distance at the intersection of NW 98th & Agnew Road. Doug Pillard will make contact with Al and determine what can be done. The Agnew Road between the West County Line and Highway #79 is in the Six-Year Program for Engineering, so no changes to the Program are needed
- 2) Mr. & Mrs. Kubr of 10233 Saltillo Road have concerns about the dust along Saltillo. We have graded this road to get it ready for the anticipated need for paving when money would be available. We will monitor this road in the spring and early summer as to the dust and determine if this road would need to have Chloride treatments for dust control. This road is properly placed in the Six-Year Program for paving so no changes are necessary.
- 3) Lecia Teten (10750 NW 121st) & Valerie Popp (11688 W. Bluff Road), both land owners, had the same concerns about W. Bluff Road between NW 112th and NW 140th Street. Their concerns were about general maintenance on the road and the amount of traffic. We will get traffic counts while school is in session and determine if this road should be added to the Six-Year Program for Engineering for future grading. No change to the Program at this time.
- 4) Bill Ashburn, Hillcrest Country Club on East "O" Street will have some impact when 98th Street is opened between "A" Street and "O" Street. We have met several times to hear their concerns. The culvert and erosion on the outlet of the culvert seems to be the greatest concern; and, we have stated that every effort would be made to address the erosion potential, but we cannot address what has yet to occur. No change to the Program.

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- 5) Burdete Piening of 11700 West "A" Street had no requests, just wanted to express his appreciation to the Maintenance guys for the mowing and tree clearing in the road right-of-way. He was also impressed with our Solar powered flashing lights.
- 6) Jeff Keiser of 13440 S. 25th Street and Camp Sun Shine is interested in improvements to S. 25th Street, south of Saltillo for about 1.5 miles. We agree that the counts would warrant adding this road to the Six-Year Program.

We would request your favorable approval of the One and Six Year Road & Bridge Program subject to the additions noted in this letter.
