AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF TRAFFIC SIGNS IN LANCASTER COUNTY

) RESOLUTION NO. R-12-0102

WHEREAS, NEB. REV. STAT. § 60-6,121 (Reissue 2004) provides that placement of traffic control devices is within the jurisdiction of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineering Department, in conjunction with the Norris School District, has informed the County Board that it is in the best interest of the traveling public to remove the "School Bus Stop Ahead" signs at the following locations:

- 1. On Yankee Hill Road east of 11020 Yankee Hill Road for westbound traffic
2. On Rokeby Road east of 3501 Rokeby Road for westbound traffic


WHEREAS, the County Engineering Department, in conjunction with Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad ("BNSF"), has informed the County Board that it is in the best interest of the traveling public to remove the "Stop" signs for east and westbound traffic on West Pioneers Boulevard at the intersection with the BNSF approximately 3500' west of SW 56th Street which were installed pursuant to County Resolution R-03-0115.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, that authorization is hereby given to remove such traffic signs at the locations designated herein.
