WHEREAS, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 13-519(1)(a), as amended by LB 492 (2019), provides that:

[N]o governmental unit shall adopt a budget containing a total of budgeted restricted funds more than the last prior year's total of budgeted restricted funds plus allowable growth plus the basic allowable growth percentage of the base limitation established under section 77-3446;

WHEREAS, the basic allowable growth percentage of the base limitation established under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 77-3446, as amended by LB675 (2019), is two and one-half percent (2 ½%); and


WHEREAS, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 13-519(2), as amended by LB 492 (2019), provides that:

A governmental unit may exceed the limit provided in subdivision (1)(a)[of Neb. Rev. Stat. §13-519] for a fiscal year by up to an additional one percent upon the affirmative vote of at least seventy-five percent of the governing body;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, that the budgeted restricted funds for Fiscal Year 2021 - 2022 plus allowable growth plus the base limitation established under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 77-3446 may be exceeded by an additional one percent (1%) as provided by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 13-519(2), as amended by LB 492 (2019).


