WHEREAS, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 13-510 (Reissue 2012), provides that:

Whenever during the current fiscal year or biennial period it becomes apparent to a government body that due to unforeseen emergencies there is temporarily insufficient money in a particular fund to meet the requirements of the adopted budget of expenditures for that fund, the governing body may by a majority vote, unless otherwise provided by state law, transfer money from other funds to such fund. No expenditure during any fiscal year or biennial period shall be made in excess of the amounts indicated in the adopted budget statement, except as authorized in section 13-511, or by state law. Any officer or officers of any governing body who obligates funds contrary to the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a Class V misdemeanor.

WHEREAS, during the current fiscal year it has become apparent that due to unforeseen emergencies there are insufficient funds in the General Fund Veterans Services Budget to meet necessary expenditures; and

WHEREAS, those unforeseen emergencies are additional costs due to salary increases not in the agency adopted budget; and


WHEREAS, careful study has been made of funds needed for necessary expenditures for the remainder of the fiscal year; and


WHEREAS, sufficient funds were appropriated in the General Fund Miscellaneous Budget as a source for obtaining funds to provide additional appropriations.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, that an appropriation transfer in the amount of \$3,000 be and hereby is transferred from the General Fund Miscellaneous Budget to the General Fund Veterans Services Budget.




