**WHEREAS**, the importance of public awareness and education are key elements for a better understanding of those characteristics associated with disaster planning; and


**WHEREAS**, September 2023 has been designated as National Preparedness Month to provide a process for the general public to adopt disaster plans for home, school and the workplace; and
