WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 23-1204 & 23-3403 (Reissue 2012), the Lancaster County Board of County Commissioners (County Board) possesses the authority to set the salaries of Deputy County Attorneys; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 23-2525 (Reissue 2012), the County Board has previously adopted Personnel Rules and Pay Plans that are applicable to classified service employees who are not covered by a labor agreement; and

WHEREAS, the County Board seeks to establish a salary and compensation plan for attorneys which equalizes the attorney classifications with other professional classifications contained within the classified service; and

WHEREAS, on December 11, 2012, the County Board previously passed Resolution R-12-0099 which established a pay plan for the Attorney I classification; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2013, the County Board previously passed Resolution R-13-0001 which established a pay plan for Attorney II classification.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, as follows:

1. Definitions

- A. Budget year shall mean Lancaster County’s fiscal budget year beginning July 1 and ending June 30 of the following calendar year.
- B. County Board shall mean the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners.
- C. Elected Official shall mean the County Attorney.

2. Supervising Attorney Compensation

- A. The Supervising Attorney classification shall have a minimum annual salary of \$122,187.52 and a maximum annual salary of \$152,734.40.
- B. Each budget year, beginning January 1, 2024, the Elected Official shall be provided with a sum equal to 2.5% of the aggregate value of the Supervising
