PROTESTS REGARDING REAL PROPERTY IN) RESOLUTION NO. R-19-0043

TO AUGUST 10, 2019)

WHEREAS, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 77-1502(1) provides that the county board of equalization shall meet for the purpose of reviewing and deciding written protests regarding real property filed pursuant to Section 77-1502 beginning on or after June 1 and ending on or before July 25 of each year;

WHEREAS, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 77-1502(1) further provides that the county board in a county with a population of more than one hundred thousand inhabitants based upon the most recent federal decennial census may adopt a resolution to extend the deadline for hearing protests regarding real property from July 25 to August 10 of each year;

WHEREAS, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 77-1502(1) provides that such resolution must be adopted before July 25 of each year and will affect the time for hearing protests for that year only;

WHEREAS, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 77-1502(6) provides that on or before August 18 in a county that has adopted a resolution to extend the deadline for hearing protests, the county clerk shall mail to the protester written notice of the county board of equalization’s decision;

WHEREAS, Lancaster County (“County”) is a county with a population of more than one hundred thousand inhabitants based upon the most recent federal decennial census;

WHEREAS, the Lancaster County Board of County Commissioners (“Board”) desires to extend the deadline for hearing protests in the County from July 25, 2019, to August 10, 2019, for those protests filed in 2019; and


WHEREAS, the Board desires that the County Clerk’s Office mail to each protester written notice of the County Board of Equalization’s decision on or before August 18, 2019;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board that the deadline for hearing protests regarding real property in the County shall be extended from July 25, 2019, to August 10, 2019, for those protests filed in 2019;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Clerk’s Office shall mail to any protester written notice of the County Board of Equalization’s decision on or before August 18, 2019.
