## Instructions To Voter

You are a voter residing in the Lincoln Public Schools District. This is your ballot for the Lincoln Public Schools Bond Election. The date of the Election is February 11, 2020. Per Nebraska State Law this election is being conducted through the mail and no polling locations will be used. Below you will find the instructions on how to cast your ballot and return it.

Nebraska Law requires that the signature of an election official must appear at the bottom of your ballot. If there is not a signature on your ballot, please contact the Lancaster County Election Commissioner's Office immediately at (402) 441-7311

### How to Vote the Ballot

- Use a black ink pen to mark your ballot. Do not use a marker.
- To vote you must blacken the oval completely.
- If you make a mistake in marking your ballot, do not cross out or erase the error. Write "VOID" across the face of the ballot and call the Lancaster County Election Commission at (402) 441-7311 for instructions.

### How to Return the Voted Ballot

- 1) Place the voted ballot in the Identification Envelope and seal. Do Not Place more than one ballot in the envelope.
- 2) Sign the Identification Envelope & Voter's Oath where indicated and provide your street address on the 'Residence Address' line.
- 3) If you are returning your ballot by mail, place one (1) first class postage stamp on the envelope.
- 4) Mail or hand-deliver your ballot to the Lancaster County Election Office, 601 N 46th St., Lincoln, NE 68503
  - For your convenience, a Drop Box is located outside the main entrance of the Election Office.
- 5) All ballots must be in the possession of the Lancaster County Election Commissioner no later than 5:00 p.m., February 11, 2020.

**Failure to complete and sign the Identification Envelope/Voter's Oath may result in your ballot NOT being counted.**

"Shall Lancaster County School District 0001 (Lincoln Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska issue its general obligation bonds in an aggregate stated principal amount not to exceed Two Hundred Ninety Million Dollars (\$290,000,000), for the purpose of paying the costs of (1) constructing, furnishing and equipping a high school near the northwest area of the District, a high school near the southeast area of the District and an elementary school near the northeast area of the District, (2) constructing, furnishing, equipping, renovating, remodeling and repairing Park Middle School and Everett Elementary School, (3) constructing, furnishing, equipping, renovating, remodeling and repairing focus program facilities, early childhood facilities and athletic and activity facilities, (4) constructing, furnishing, equipping, renovating, remodeling and repairing various District facilities, additions and infrastructure throughout the District, and (5) acquiring sites and constructing related infrastructure improvements for school facilities of the District; such bonds to be issued from time to time as may be determined by the Board of Education, to bear interest at a rate or rates to be determined by the Board of Education and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by the Board of Education; and

"Shall the School District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the School District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due?"

Electors voting in favor of such proposition shall blacken the oval opposite the words "FOR such Bonds and tax" following such proposition, and electors voting against such proposition shall blacken the oval opposite the words "AGAINST such Bonds and tax" following such proposition.
