Welcome to East High School Truancy Diversion Program (TDP) 2020/2021

We are here to partner with you to improve your attendance in school and improve your academic career as well. As part of that partnership we will:

1. Meet with you on an ongoing basis to share what is going well, what supports you may need and provide you with those supports.
2. Meet as a team 2 times a month to review progress and areas of improvement.
3. Provide academic and behavioral support at East.
4. Celebrate your attendance and academic progress.

Members of the East TDP team include Tami Rembolt (East TDP coordinator and school Social Worker), Sue Cassata (Principal) and Jera Guill (Attendance Technician). Along with Chris Turner (Juvenile Division, County Attorney's Office), they will work closely with you and your parents/guardians to help support you through the Truancy Diversion Program but also help support your successful attendance and academic success at East.

Academic supports that may be put into place through TDP include the following:

1. Learning Hubs - academic support offered through each department during each lunch period. First 15 and last 15 minutes of periods 4, 5 and 6.
2. Academic Hour - offered on Monday, Tuesday and Thursdays from 3:15 - 4:00 p.m in the Media Center. Teachers are available in the areas of Math, English and General Support.
3. Before/Afterschool work with individual teachers.
4. Spartans Success
